ASCC NEWS... ...AND NOTES

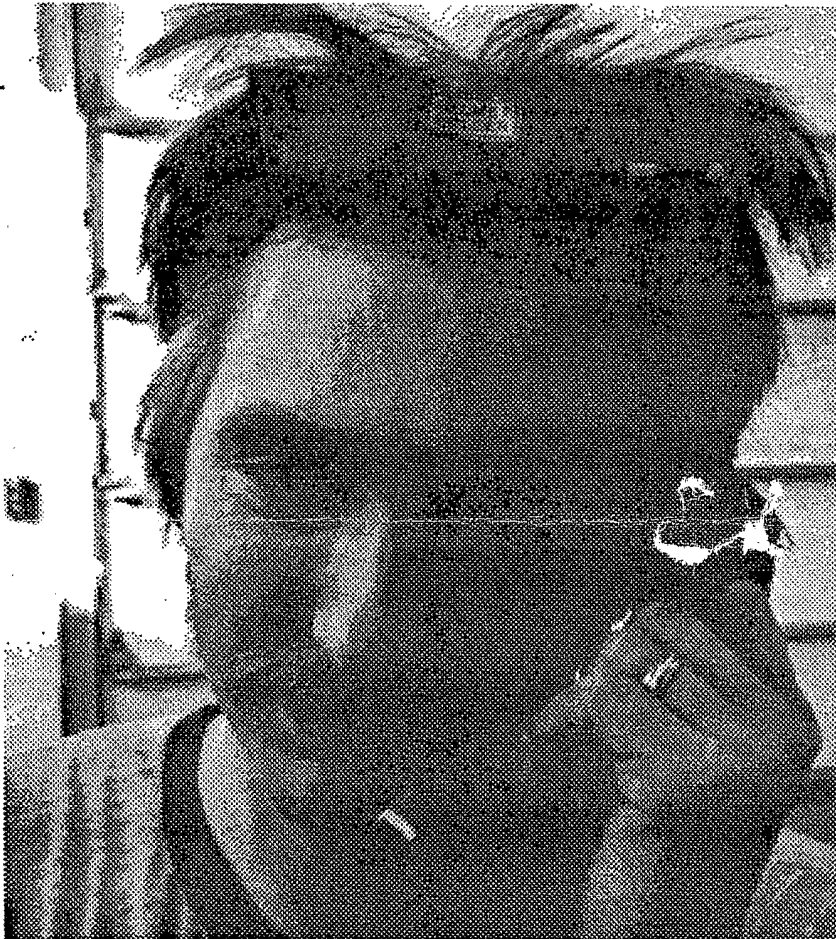
Don't forget the December ASCC club meeting. Hustle on down to Pioneer Honda, Tuesday, December 14th at 7:30 p.m.
